General Camping Information and Rules Contract Rider

Hook-ups: There are no full hook-ups anywhere on the grounds.

Water: Please use splitters for water. By New York State Health Dept. regulation, backflow preventers must be on both sides.

Electricity: You are allowed only one plug-in per site. Additional plugs will be disconnected.

Please be aware that in order to obtain the most electric sites, leads will have to be proper size and length to reach outlets. There must be 3 feet from any camper to any breaker panel. New York State Health Dept. requires a distance of at least 10 feet between campers. Our electric sites are a combination of 20, 30, and 50 amp sites.

Due to limitations on electric, it is not possible to run both A/C and microwaves and other appliances at the same time. Excessive tripping of breakers because of the above will result in your breaker not being reset.

NYS Regs. : There will be no open fires. There will be no barbecuing within 25 feet of a trailer or awnings. All fire lanes must be maintained open at all times.

Parking: Everything that is yours, including your vehicle, must be within the boundaries of your site or parked in an authorized parking area.

Black and Gray Water: There is no dumping station on the grounds. Black or gray water may not be dumped on the grounds. Anyone found to be discharging their sewer (gray or black water) or holding tanks onto the fairgrounds or adjoining property may be removed from the fairgrounds and will be subject to fines here-with. Gray water discharge violations will carry a \$250 fine. Black water discharge violations will carry a \$1000 fine. The decision of violation will be the sole responsibility of the Saratoga County Agricultural Society. Fair grounds personnel will be checking daily both during the day and night. New York State Health Dept. code stipulates that water discharge from a trailer or food stand is considered sewage. Pump out service is only available with advance contact with the Fair Office.

Waste: Village of Ballston Spa ordinance requires that all dog owners/handlers/walkers/ etc. pick up dog waste and dispose of it properly.

Payment: Camper site rentals are due on or before the last day of the event. Fairgrounds personnel will be doing a verification of accounting.

Picnic Tables: Picnic tables may be available to campers during their stay, availability will vary by event. Check with the Fair Office prior to your event. Picnic tables located in pavilions are for use by all users at an event and are not to be removed from the pavilions for any reason. Any damage to picnic tables will incur a \$100 replacement fee.

It is understood that by signing this rider to this contract the renter has read and is agreeing to the rules and terms set forth in this rider in addition to the rules in the contract.
